

The cottage



The cottage is a two-storey A-frame, finished in natural pine. It features:

- a large, open living/dining room with a wood stove
- a fully-equipped kitchen
- one bedroom on the ground floor, with a queen-size bed
- an open loft with a double bed, a double futon, a roll-away single bed, and room to spare
- a pull-out couch in the living room



Everything is bright and comfortable. From the loft there is a deck where you can watch the sun set over the sea.



The cottage is well supplied with books, games, a radio, and a small refractor telescope for those amazing starry nights. There is no TV.

Availability

The cottage is available for \$900 per week during June or July 2010.

The location



The site is on the North Shore of Prince Edward Island, in a quiet cottage community a few minutes' walk from dunes and white sand beaches. Nearby is the village of Morell and the fishing wharf at Red Head Harbour.

Swimming

The beach is on the Gulf of St. Lawrence, a sheltered, comparatively warm body of water. Most days there are gentle waves, delightful for swimming. You can walk along the beach for miles, but stay near the tideline and keep dogs leashed to protect the

piping plovers that nest in the area. Also, please remember that the large sand dunes are part of a fragile ecosystem and won't survive trampling.



Cycling and hiking

The Confederation Trail follows the old railway bed through the nearby village of Morell and along the sunny shore of St.

Peters Bay—the most scenic stretch of Trail on the island. If you like walking, you'll enjoy the new national park and interpretive centre at Greenwich, on the other side of St. Peters Bay.

Golfing

The renowned Crowbush Golf Course is just minutes away, and the well-established Brudenell course is half an hour away across rolling hills.
